

Bone Stock Compact and Bone Stock Mini Van Rules

2024

Bone stock class is open to all men and women 16 and over, if under the age of 18 you must have the permission signed by both parents/guardians at the event. If both parents/guardians are not present to sign at the event, the permission will need to be notarized with the required signatures.

Driver may move forward or backward. Driver must make contact every 60 seconds or be disqualified. No sandbagging. If you sandbag the race will be stopped and a sandbagger flag will be put on top of your car. You must show visible damage or must move when hit.

Prize Money:

Is different for every show. Check schedule for payout.

Driver Rules:

Drivers and passengers must be at least 18 years of age or IF 16 or 17 years of age must have a notarized permission by parent/guardian. Drivers must furnish his/her own car. If this is a passenger heat all drivers, passengers and pit persons must sign a waiver of release of liability before entering pit area or track. Entries will be accepted up to one hour prior to race time. You must be there at least one hour before the show. IF YOU ARE NOT IN LINE TO BE CHECKED IN AT LEAST AN HOUR BEFORE START TIME, YOU WILL BE CHARGED AN EXTRA \$20.00 for late check-in. All drivers and pit people must attend the meeting prior to race time.

MANDATORY PASSENGER RULES:

Must at least have a secure 4 pt. cage approved by officials for driver and passenger safety. Must have a T- handle or something similar to hold onto. Seat must be bolted down in stock position. Must have a seat belt. Must have enough padding to protect the rider. If you do not have the items, you will not be able to run passengers. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

Must have name on BOTH front doors and at least a 15x15 roof sign with name and number on it big and bright enough to read. Use your number of choice with NO profanity.

Preparation of Cars:

Front wheel drive or rear wheel drive cars. No 4x4's or **ALL WHEEL DRIVES** and no pacers. Wheelbase not to exceed 107 inches from center of wheel to center of wheel (must be factory 107 inches cannot move wheels in). All glass, chrome, pot metal, head lights, taillights, back seat and anything flammable must be removed.

Rules below are the **ABSOLUTE** max you may do to a car:

1. Dash may be removed
2. Cars need to be 4 or 6 cylinders only

3. Stock gas tank can be used under car if it's in front of the rear axle. If changed to inside, it must be a metal fuel cell (NO EXCEPTIONS). Must be secured properly and no fuel leakage. No more than 6 gallons of gas.
4. Battery must be relocated to inside of the car but must be secured properly (1 automotive battery)
5. Hood must have a 5x5 hole cut in it to extinguish fires. Hood must open for inspection and must remain on hinges. You can use 8 pieces of 3/8 chain in 6 spots in hood to fender. 2 from hood to bumper or you can use 9 wire the same way with 3 wraps per fastening spot. Must have windshield bar from top of windshield to top of fire wall. You can use 9 wire, chain or 3-inch flat metal. 2 max in this area.
6. Trunks must be on hinges. You can use 8 pieces of 3/8 chain in trunk, 6 to fasten trunk lid and 2 from trunk lid to bumper. Or you can use 9 wire the same way with 3 wraps per fastening spot. You can tuck 50% of trunk lid only or remove trunk lid completely
7. BUMPERS can be bolted on with two 3/4 x 8-inch all-thread with 3-inch washers. As stated in rules 4 & 5 you can also use 9 wire or chain along with bolting. Can run 80's and newer bumper or 4x4 square tubing 1/4" thick. Bumpers can be hardnosed. May weld bumper to frame. Bumper CANNOT be any wider than car.
8. Doors you can use 6 pieces of 3/8 chain per door or 6 pieces of 9 wire per door with 3 wraps. May weld doors solid 3" or smaller strap. Both front doors you can have a six-inch-wide piece of channel or equivalent from 6 inches in front of front doors to 6 inches behind front doors. May be welded solid or bolted. May have bar behind front seat no further back than 3 inches behind front seat.
9. Tires: D.O.T. approved light truck tires max. NO V-Treads or Skid Steer Tires!
10. Header Pipes are allowed
11. Rear End: Locking of rear ends permitted
12. Frame: Notching of frame permitted but cannot be welded back together
13. May use small weld in centers in wheels

This is the max of what you can do on a bone stock car. DO NOT do anymore than this or you won't be running this class.

**** YOU WILL GET ONE CHANCE TO MAKE CHANGES TO THE CAR AFTER INSPECTION. IF NOT DONE LIKE WE ASK, CAR WILL REMAIN ON THE TRAILER. JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL. ****
